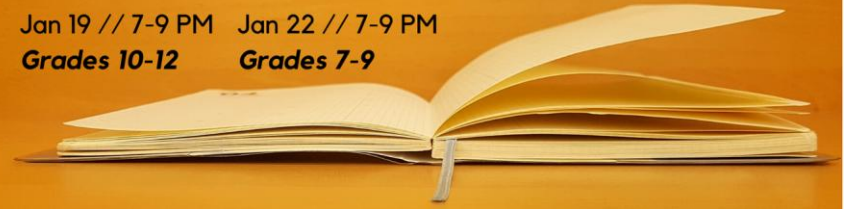


STAY "IN THE LOOP" WITH THE HEARTBEAT & MISSION OF MAC

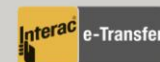

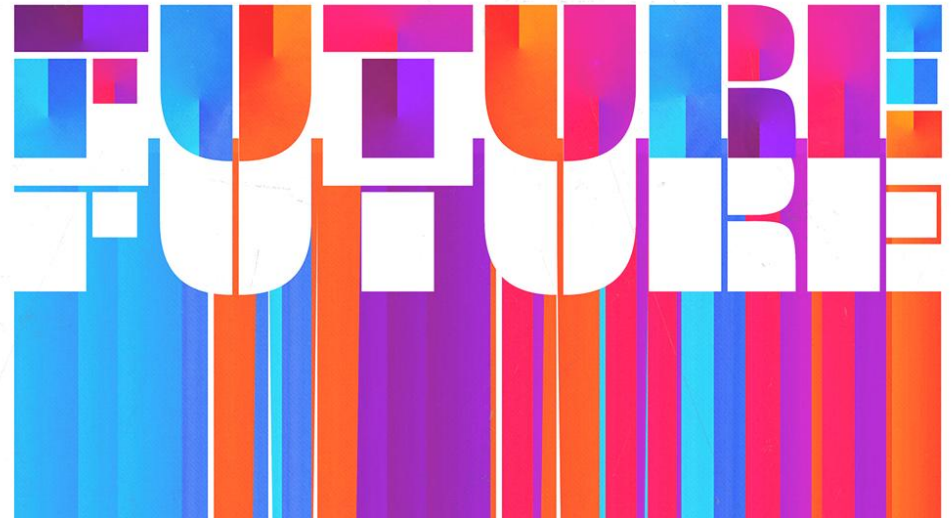
